

**Test-Taking Errors to Avoid (based on your analysis):**

Knowledge error: did not know the material covered.

Decision-making error: knew material fairly well and could narrow down to two responses but did not choose the best answer

Test-taking error: Misread questions stem or one or more answer choice. Made assumptions. Did not read all answer choices.
